

Cookie policy for Vaccine Information and Management System (VIMS)

When you access the Vaccine Information and Management System (VIMS), through the www.vims.nvi.go.th website of the National Vaccine Institute (hereinafter referred to as "NVI"), the information related to your website access will be recorded in the form of cookies. This cookie policy will explain what cookies are, how they work, why use cookies and how to delete or disable the cookies for your privacy, which accessing this website, you are deemed to have consented to NVI's use of cookies in accordance with the following cookie policy.

1. What are Cookies?

A cookie is the file that records information about how you used the site, including the date and time, the links you clicked, the pages you visited, and different configuration settings. Cookies are saved on your computer and/or communication devices, such as a laptop, tablet, or smartphone, through web browsers. In the following circumstances, your personal information may be gathered to improve your use of online services by identifying your language preferences and customizing usage data according to your preferences to confirm your unique characteristics and ensure the security of your data. Furthermore, cookies are used to measure the volume of online service usage and to change content according to your usage behavior in the past and present.

2. How does NVI use Cookies?

NVI uses cookies to collect your website visit and registration/login data to help NVI remember your online behaviors and other settings on the NVI website. NVI will use cookie data to improve our website to deliver a more personalized and convenient experience to you. In addition, NVI may use a third-party cookie to achieve such purpose, which requires the use of IP Address, statistical cookies as well as data linkage and data analysis as the purpose of NVI.

NVI uses the 2 types of cookies, which are classified based on its storage type, as follows:

1. Session Cookies are cookies that last for a session to remember you while browsing www.vims.nvi.go.th website, such as your preferred language, and are removed from your computer or device when you leave the site or shut down your browser.

2. Persistent Cookie are cookies that are stored on your computer or device for a determined period or until deleted. They will help www.vims.nvi.go.th website in remembering you and other setting/preference on your subsequent visits for a more convenient and faster experience.

3. The purposes of Cookies use.

NVI's cookies can also be classified based on their purposes of use, the types of which are as follows:

- 1. Strictly Necessary Cookies are essential for functionality of www.vims.nvi.go.th website service to enable you to access or use some features of website and to remember the information you previously provided through the website. Disabling the use of this type of cookies may have an impact on the functionality of the www.vims.nvi.go.th website because certain functions require the use of cookies, which is necessary.
- 2. Performance Cookies allow NVI to recognize user interactions, most visited page of www.vims.nvi.go.th website as well as analytics of usage/behavior data. NVI will use these cookie data to improve the website's performance. However, all information these cookies collect is anonymous and will be used only for a statistical purpose. Disabling the use of this type of cookie may impact NVI's ability to determine website visitor statistics and evaluate the quality of service provided.
- **3. Functional Cookies** allow <u>www.vims.nvi.go.th</u> website to remember the choices you make on the setting and will assist the website in providing you with more personalized features and contents, such as your account, username and language or remembering the changes to the font size or other settings on the webpage that you can customize. Disabling the use of this type of cookie may impact the website's ability to function properly.
